### Principal Message

I don't normally write opinion pieces for the school newsletter but yesterday's comments from the Federal Minister for Education Mr Pyne have caused me great concern. As you would all be aware we are commencing our first year under the new 'Gonski' funding arrangements in 2014. As a needs based funding model this goes a long way to correcting the present system that fails to recognise that some children need more help in their education than others. The NSW government was very quick to sign on with this system and the NSW DEC has moved very efficiently to provide schools with accurate indications of the quantum of funding they will receive in 2014, as well ballpark indications of what to look forward to in the first four years of the funding cycle. Mr Pyne has said he wants the system replaced because it is a 'shambles'. Toormina Public School has received a very comprehensive funding document from the NSW DEC that relates to every facet of the operation of the school. It is anything but a shambles. It is clearly set out, it explains why we get the funding we do, and provides a very clear framework for the school to plan and implement quality teaching and learning programs for every child. It would be an extremely poor move, in my opinion, if the Minister were to ignore the extensive research and input that went into the Gonski Review and throw out the new allocation model just one year into its existence.

On a positive note, our Intensive Swimming scheme has kicked off this week with some kind weather and plenty of enthusiasm from the children. The groups have been sorted and activities have begun in earnest. This very

important program will continue through to Friday 6th December.

This week will be the last week for Kindergarten Orientation. We will be seeking feedback from parents on Friday to help us in our planning for 2014 orientation programs. If your child has been part of this year's program we would like to hear from you about aspects you found helpful as well as your ideas on what might be done to improve the experience both for parents and their children. A survey sheet will be made available to you at school this Friday.
