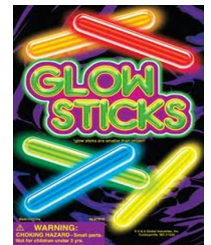
MEGA CHRISTMAS RAFFLE – “STUDENT INCENTIVE PRIZE”
