

K-RED GETTING CALM IN CLASS

The students of Kinder RED are benefiting from the introduction of many new learning strategies this year.

The use of weighted animal toys placed on children's laps helps increase the students attention as well as acting as a calming tool. Fidget toys have also been found to increase concentration.

A daily visual schedule outlines the daily school routine with sloped writing boards, pencil grips and regular movement breaks incorporated into the day to get the wriggles out. Yoga breaks have also been introduced to teach students how to achieve calm & relaxed feelings in themselves.

The latest in dynamic rocking chairs have been purchased for the classroom, with funds kindly provided by Sawtell Rotary Club. These chairs are great for students who are unable to sit still, making it easy for them to relax and focus on learning activities. Our school P&C Committee have also just donated money to buy sensory ear muffs that will further assist the students who find noises in the school overwhelming.

This year Kinder RED has also benefited from regular visits from Occupational Therapist Marg Hopper, who has been implementing different programs and is teaching students all about self-regulation.
