

FEES: Depending on the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) and activity hours a parent is entitled too, the out of pocket costs to parents can range from a few dollars to the full rate shown below. Your fee will vary depending on your own CCS rate and activity hours you receive. Please note excursions are at an additional cost shown on the next page and these costs will have your CCS % applied to substantially reduce excursion costs.
