As you are aware it is important to let the school know when your child is absent from school and to provide a reason for this absence within 7 days. Last Monday we began trialling a new system to address absences within Toormina Public School. If your child is marked absent in the class roll by the teacher and a reason hasn't been given then you will receive an SMS from the school. You are able to reply to this message with the reason for the absence and it will be entered into our system. If a reply hasn't been received by Thursday afternoon then a letter will be generated and sent home with your child. You can then fill out the slip and return this to school. Please feel free to continue to call the front office or notify the teacher directly on SeeSaw or Skoolbag. This is a trial system, so if you have any problems or concerns, please call the office and let us know. We look forward to making it easier for our families to communicate with our school.
